General information

LAND ROLL AND MUNICIPAL TAXES

The new three-year property roll (2023 to 2025) was filed on October 27, 2022. The property value increase is 37% for the average home assessment and the overall roll increase is 35%. This strong increase is due to the rise in the real estate market, which has been present for several years. Rest assured that the tax rate for your 2023 account will be adjusted to limit the increase to a reasonable level.

If the new municipal assessment does not seem appropriate, you can contest it. To do so, you must fill out a form requesting a review of your municipality's assessment roll. You have until April 30 of the first year of application of the assessment roll to file your request with the MRC d'Argenteuil.

The property assessment roll is a portrait of the inventory of buildings located on the territory of a municipality, assessed on the same basis and on the same date.

Functions of the Assessment Roll

Indicate all the information required for the purposes of municipal and school property taxation;

Ensure the transparency of Quebec property taxation by allowing any interested person to access this information;

Allow any taxpayer to compare the listings relating to his property with those of other similar buildings.

WORKS CARRIED OUT IN 2022

The main works carried out by the public works department are the insertion of a culvert under chemin Avoca at the Constantineau intersection, the repair and paving of chemin kilmar in the pommiers section, installation of the second layer of paving on the main street in the village of Calumet, repair and placement of foundation layers on Harrington Road between the fire station and the church, other maintenance work, road marking and sealing of cracks were carried out on several roads in the municipality.



REGULATIONS CONCERNING PUBLIC ROADS

Little reminder. It is forbidden to shovel, blow or push snow onto the street and sidewalks. You must place it on your land. For everyone's safety, snowbanks at the edge of the street or your garage entrance must not exceed more than 2.5m. Companies that remove snow from private properties are subject to these same rules. If you do not respect these regulations, you expose yourself to fines



WINTER PARKING

From November 1st until May 1st, overnight parking is prohibited on the streets between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Parking on the south side of the main street is prohibited at all times.

At any time, you can consult the information that applies to your unit of assessment on the municipality's website in the "Economic life/ Finance/ Assessment and Taxation" tab and then on the "Voilà! Propriété" icon.

PROPERTY ASSESSMENT

The assessment roll contains the inventory of buildings located within the municipality's territory. The roll is tabled every three years. It can be consulted during office hours at city hall, or online as indicated below.

Quebec Property Assessment Roll Data Now Available on the Données Québec Website

As of May 18, 2022, data from Québec's property assessment roles are available in open format on the Données Québec website. This release will notably facilitate public access to data from the evaluation roles. Nevertheless, in order to preserve the confidentiality of the owners, the names of the owners of the evaluation units and their mailing addresses have been removed.

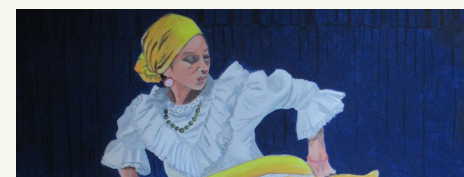
