Carillon spillway refurbishment project



Hydro-Québec invests in Carillon to rejuvenate the generating station. The refurbishment of the spillway will look at ways to ensure the spillway's long-term operability and its compliance with applicable standards.




Project description

The Carillon spillway has 12 gates and was built between 1960 and 1963. In the months ahead, Hydro-Québec will conduct a number of studies and analyze different scenarios to determine the final scope of the project.

The project will include the following:

- **Determination** of sensitive elements, work impacts and necessary mitigation measures
- Assessment of the need to intervene on embankment dikes around the generating station
- Refurbishment of the spillway
