

PUMPKIN DECORATING CONTEST - HALLOWEEN 2024 RULES



1. General description of the contest

On the occasion of Halloween 2024, the Municipality of Grenville-sur-la-Rouge invites its young citizens to embellish the Town Hall lobby by participating in a decorated pumpkin contest.

The contest will run from October 7, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. to October 28, 2024 at 4:30 p.m.

2. How to enter

Participants must drop off their decorated pumpkin at Town Hall, 88 des Érables, during Town Hall opening hours, between October 7 and October 28, 2024 inclusively. No entries will be accepted after this date.

When dropping off their pumpkin, participants must fill out a registration form and an identification card for their pumpkin.

There is no registration limit.

3. Eligibility requirements

Participants must reside in Grenville-sur-la-Rouge.

Children of municipal staff and elected officials are not eligible to enter the contest.

4. Requirements for pumpkins on display

For conservation reasons, decorated pumpkins must not be pierced, gutted or carved (the skin must remain intact). No pierced or carved pumpkins will be accepted.

There is no minimum or maximum limit on pumpkin sizes.

5. Prize categories

Prizes will be awarded in 2 categories:

Children (12 and under)

1st prize: \$40 gift certificate to Méli-Mélo Rigolo in Lachute

2nd prize: \$20 gift certificate to Méli-Mélo Rigolo in Lachute





Youth (ages 13-18)

1st prize: \$50 gift certificate to Cartes et Créations Léo in Lachute

2nd prize: \$25 gift certificate to Cartes et Créations Léo in Lachute

Total value of prizes: \$135

6. Awarding of prizes

Winners will be determined by a jury of municipal employees, based on originality, quality of execution and age-appropriateness (parents, please don't help your children too much!).

The winning pumpkins will be unveiled on Tuesday, November 5.

7. Prize acceptance

Winners will be notified by telephone or e-mail from November 5 to November 8, 2024. If we are unable to contact a winner during this period, the prize will be awarded to the 2nd place winner, and so on, until the prize has been awarded.

Winners must pick up their prize at the Town Hall during opening hours.

Prizes are not exchangeable, redeemable for cash or transferable. Prizes must be accepted as awarded.

Refusal to accept a prize releases the Municipality from any obligation related to said prize. Upon taking possession of the prize, the winner's adult representative must sign a form acknowledging receipt of the prize and releasing the Municipality from any liability in connection with the prize.

8. Modification

The Municipality reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this contest in whole or in part, for any reason whatsoever.

In no event shall the Municipality be required to award more prizes than those indicated in these rules or to award prizes other than in accordance with these rules.
